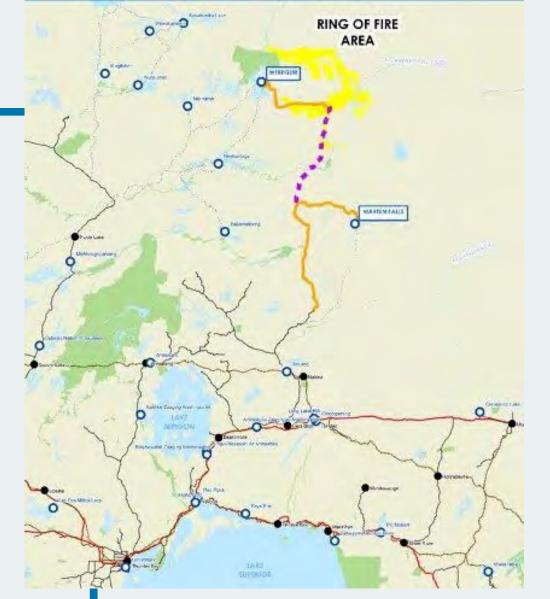

ECONOMIC ANALYSIS BY CEDC

Using Rotman School and Premier Gold data of one of the new mine projects:
Greenstone Gold's Hardrock Mine, the following can be said:
\$301M in annual GDP contribution from mine of this size to Ontario
\$106M in annual taxes and royalties to government (\$63M to Ontario per year) (Rotman School/OMA #s).
